  - o Mora: La GP y la Holloway is dangerous because several trucks just spill their trash in the area and don't clean it up. There are times you can't even see the road under all that they spill. The company I work for we make sure our trucks don't leave dirty so they don't dirty the Holloway. The truckers are mad and mention that the other company down the road just lets them leave as they are.
  - We have 2-3 people make sure the trucks leave clean.
  - Ana R: La GP y la Holloway there is a horrible odor when we go to work in that area. We think its due to the sludge that comes from LA. It also has a strong odor of oil and gas production so I think its contaminated dirk from the oilfields being dumbed there as well. We have been seeing more and more truck come through the community
  - Saul: I've seen those trucks in the morning filled to the brim with contaminants they stop in front of my house on the way to Holloway.
     I can't breathe and feel like I'm choking when they stop
  - Jesus: it maybe the landfill that recently had an expansion approved to allow for more toxic waste

- Ana MD: I don't understand how they are allowed to just pile more and more pollution on us.
- Everyone: HM Holloway Inc is the one that allows trucks to overspill on to the road.
- Gustavo we are asking the state to provide us with a list of companies in our boundaries. data would be NOx, pm2.5 emissions etc. we would have that data available to us. GIS Map.

  - We are able to see the different contaminants. We can see each square how many tons of contaminants are present.
  - This is how we can build our profile.
  - We can see stationary sources, and how much they are producing.
  - We can see their proximity to sensitive receptors like people and animals
  - If we don't do it this way we will submit a PRR for all this data
