Community Emission Inventory

Assembly Bill 617 (C. Garcia, Chapter 36, Statutes of 2017) requires the development of community emission reduction programs (CERP) to reduce emissions and impacts in AB 617 communities. CARB's Community Air Protection Blueprint requires community-scale emission inventories to serve as the foundation to assess current conditions, develop emission reduction strategies, and track progress.

CARB and the Air Districts collaboratively, with input from the community steering committee (CSC), develop community-scale emission inventories to support CERP development. CARB's Community Emission Inventory StoryMaps tool is designed to present and display community-scale emission inventories consistently across the State in a centralized location and serves as a platform to assist in the review of emission inventories between communities, Air Districts, and CARB. The StoryMaps tool provides emission inventory information and data in a user-friendly manner to enable data transparency and accessibility, engage community members and stakeholders in the inventory development process and advance capacity-building goals.
