 - Cesar Aguirre, CCEJN made a presentation and example of the different equipment he will be using for part of the monitoring plan
 - *We can show up do the Bucket sample, analyze the data to prove there is something in the air and what is in the air.*
 - *Community member: between 8 and 11 in the afternoon we get these strong odors. We get use to it so we would never report it.*
 - *Cesar: we need submit a complaint sometimes that's all we need to make the change*
 - *After bucvknet sample example what time and for how ling: we submit it to the lab they take about 2-3 weeks for the samples. But once we get it we will know what is in the air.*
 - *Where should we take those samples:*
 - *Community: near the Calloway and the GP where we have*
 - *Badger street*
 - *Along the Gas Facility near the school*

- *Near the 5 and the gasoline stations*
- *What time is the worst?*
 - *Community: within the week its worst, for the Wonderful plant all the time but especially during the week*
 - *The weekend not so much*
 - *On the weekend on badger between 9 and 10 at night*
 - *In the community at 4 to 7 everyday because they begin to pasture*
 - *Calloway during the morning*
 - *9-11 at night its smells like sewage*
- *Based on the reports we will determine when will be the best time to go out into the community*
- *We will coordinate will CWF and the VAD to see if they would like to co monitor or sample along side us.*
- *Residents will be able join us when we go out to take samples*
- *Actualización de la Solicitud de Datos y Perfiles (CCAC) 30 mins*
 - *Update on Data and Profile Request (CCAC) 30 mins*
 - *Brianda Castro, CCAC, gave an update on the progress on the community profile request.*
 - *after the boundary was submitted we made an official request to CARB and VAD. Gustavo met with CARB last week. CARB said in about 3 months work with air district to get the data sooner. They shared it was a big request.*
 - *CCAC also met with Stephanie from VAD*
 - *to be more efficient and accurate we are told to submit a public records request to ensure there is follow up. We need to request specifically what we want like the emissions and violations. Stephanie asked us to message her once we submit. CARB will take about 3 months*
 - *We already know who has permits. We will submit that data. We already have a list of pollution sources in the*

community profile. The thing we can ask is be specific as possible like the location and time frame we are requesting . they go case by case basis. if we do it all in one we will get delayed.

- *CARB they just need the boundary and contaminants we are looking into*
- *Community: there are areas of concern like the highway 33, Wonderful Plant, highway 46 and Interstate 5. And some area a little past Blackwell Corner.*
- *Dust and contamination concerns along the Calloway*
- *Odor/ sewage concerns south of the Park*
- *Brianda: data summary will include: emission inventories, Historical data infractions and incidents.*
- *Saul: agustin called about the bad odors of the reservoirs. He also mentioned bad odors at 6-7 in the morning and 9-10 at night. Odors are strong along Badger St. He called an inspector they were checking the bad odors. Need to follow up with Agustin. This was about 2 weeks ago.*
- *We need another training on how to enter the calls online.*
- *Cesar CCEJN: call us and we can follow up with the VAD.*
